## RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Whereas, on the 8th day of January, 1910, Edgar Flournoy and Clara Flournoy, his wife, made, executed and delivered to the Jessie Oil Company, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, an oil and gas lease upon the premises hereinafter described, which said lease was recorded in Book 74, on Page 293, in the office of register of deeds of Tulsa county, state of Oklahoma;

And whereas said lease contains the following Provision:

And now, as aforesaid, the party of the second part does hereby surrender, release, and quit claim all of its right, title and interest in and to the following described property located in Tulsa county, state of Oklahoma, to-wit:

unto the parties of the first part, their heirs, administrators, successors and assigns.

## ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASES.
