## RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

witnessed, that the lessors in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations pollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained and to be kept performed by the lessee, does hereby grant unto the lessee, his heirs, successors and assigns, all the oil and gas in and under the following described tract of land for the sole purpose and with the exclusive right of *operating thereon for oil and gas* together with the right of way over and across said premises to all places of operation by said lessee, lying adjacent thereto the right to erect derricks and all other
