described land; that notices of saidsale were Fosted in three of the mot Polic Places in the county of Tulsa, state of Oklahowa, on the 22nd day of ecomber, 1910, that Proof of said Posting has beenduly made heren; that notice of said sale was Published for two successive weeks next before the sale in the Oklahoma world, a weekly Publication of general circulation in and for the county of Than, state of Oklahoma, the fistPublication apparing on the 22nd day of Accember, 1910, and the subsequent Publications on the 29th day of Accember, 1910, and the 5th day of January, 1911; that Proof of said Publication has been duly made herin.

The court further finds that before said sale the guardian herein caused to Propedty hereinbefore described to be duly appraised by three disinterested and qualfied appraisers residents of the county of Tulsa, state of Okahoma, and that said afraisement was in due form and ducy filed inthis court before theday of sale.

The court further finds that before said sale theguardian herein filed an additinal guardianship bad as the law requires and that the same was in due form and duly approved by this court.

The court further finds that the decree of sale made inthe above entitled cause was made by this court for t he reasons set out in said guardian's Petition for sale and for the reasons set forth in said decree of sale.

The court further finds that on the 7th day of January, 1911, the date appointed for said sale, sealed bids were opened by the guardian and it was found that deff D. No objection to the confirmation of said sale being made, and the court being fully advised.

It is therefore ordered, considered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the said sale by and the same is herey confirmed and approved and declared valid, and the Proper and legal conveyance of said real estate is herby directled to be executed to said Purchaser George F.
