To all to whom these Presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, a townsite commission, hereafore appointed under the act of congress approved May 31, 1900 (31 Stats., 221) and acting under authority of the act of Congress aproved july 1, 1902 (32 Stats., 716), ratified by the Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, has ap-Praised the lots in the town of Owasso, Okla., formerly Cherokee wation, Indan Territory,

whereas, the Plat of said town was approved by the secretary of the Interior on the 26th day of March, 1904, and was duly Placed nWrile: and

Whereas, said commission has appraised all of the ten lots included in said Plat at their true value, excluding PmProvements, which appraisal has been approved by the secretary of the Interior; and

Whereas, thesaid commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Jemima kinney, who has Paid four hundred dollars, the full amount of the purchase Price into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and is, therefore, entitled to a Patent;
