

RELEASE OF MORTGAGE/

COMPLETED

Whereas, on the sixth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and nine, DePorter Huntsman, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, made and executed to the Standard Savings and Loan Association a certain real estate mortgage covering lot five (5), block one hundred eighty-seven (187) in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said mortgage being made to secure the payment of his Promissory note to said corporation for the sum of One thousand five hundred (\$1500.00) dollars, and said mortgage being recorded in book sixty-one ⁽⁶¹⁾ page four hundred fifty-eight (458) Tulsa county, Oklahoma,

And whereas, said DePorter Huntsman has sold the southerly fifty (50) feet of said lot five (5) to one W. M. Fleetwood, who, as a Part of the Purchase Price of said southerly fifty (50) feet of lot five (5), has assumed and agreed to Pay a balance of one thousand two hundred ninety-eight (\$1298.00) dollars remaining unpaid January first, 1911, on said one thousand five hundred (\$1500.00) dollar indebtedness, and has assumed all of the liabilities of said Huntsman to said Standard Savings and Loan Association,

Now, therefore, in consideration of the Payments hereto fore made on said loan and of the request of the said DePorter Huntsman and the said W. M. Fleetwood, the said Standard Savings and Loan Association hereby releases from the lien of said mortgage, the land described as the northerly fifty (50) feet of lot five (5) block one hundred eighty-seven (187) city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and retains as sole security for the balance remaining ^{on said note and mortgage the southerly half or southerly 50 fifty feet.} unpaid of said lot five (5). Said W. M. Fleetwood joins in the execution of this instrument as evidence of his assumption of the balance due on said note, ^{for the release} and of his request of the said northerly fifty (50) feet of said lot five (5).
