GUARDIAN'S DEED.

This indenture made and entered into this the 17th day of December, 1910, by and between C. C. Roberts, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of Della Lane, minor, Party of the first Part, and H. B. Boyd, of Sarcoxie, Missouri, Party of the second Part, Witnesseth:

That whereas, the above named guardian did, on the 4th day of January, 1910, file his Petition in the county court of Craig county, Oklahoma, asking for authority to sell certain lands belonging to the estate of Della Lane, minor, for the purpose of support and education of said minor; and

Whereas, on the 31st day of January, 1910, the county court of Craig county, *Oklahoma* issued an order authorizing and directing said guardian to sell the real estate hereinafter *described* at private sale to the highest and best bidder for cash, for the purpose of support and education of said minor; and

Whereas, due notice of the time, place and property to be sold, hereinafter described together with the terms of sale, were published in the Tulsa World, a newspaper, of legal circulation printed and published in said Tulsa county, for more than one year next before date first publication of said notice, for two weeks and not less than fifteen days successively next before the day on or after which such sale was to be had; and notices of such sale were posted up in three of the most public places in said Tulsa county, at least fifteen days prior to the date of sale, in which notices the lands and tenements, to be sold were described with common certainty, proofs of such publication and posting being filed in this court; and

Whereas, said guardian did heretofore execute and file an additional bond to the satisfaction of the court, conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties as
