TRANSFER AND ASSIGNMENT.

Know all men by these Presents: That this agreement made and entered into on this 2 day of February 1911, by and between W. C. Guiler, C. E. Deloe and Homer S. Grosman, Parties of the first Part, and the Oklahoma State Oil Company, Party of the second Part;

Witnesseth: That whereas said Parties of the first Part, ^{namely} W. C. Guiler, C. E. Deloe and Homer S. Grosman, are the sole and only owners of a valid, subsisting and indefeasible oil and gas lease in and to and the leasehold estate thereby created and of the oil and gas in and under the following described Premises situated in Tulsa county, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Northwest quarter of the northeast quarter and north half of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter and the north half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section twenty-nine (29), township eighteen (18) north, range thirteen (13) east, and;

whereas, the Parties hereto have agreed upon the terms of a sale, transfer and assignment of the above described Property and all the right, title and interest therein unto the said Party of the second Part, its successors and assigns.

Now therefore, in and for the consideration of the sum of \$320.00 three hundred and twenty dollar s cash in hand Paid to first Parties by second Party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said W.
