#### AGREEMENT.

This memorandum of agreement, made and entered into this 2 day of Feb A. D 1911, by and between David A. Shipman, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Lucas Oil Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, witnesseth:

That whereas, on the 22nd day of August, 1910, party of the first part executed and delivered to the party of the second part an oil and gas mining lease upon the following described lands lying and being situate in the county of Tulsa, state of Oklahoma, to-wit:

W2 of NE4 and SE4 of NE4 of section 7, township 18 north, range 15 east; and that said oil and gas lease was filed for record in the office of the register of deeds for Tulsa county, on the 29th day of August, 1910, and recorded in book 92, at page 173; And,

Whereas, thereafter the said P. J. White assigned all of his right, title and interest in and to said lease aforesaid to the Lucas Oil Company; And,

Whereas, it was provided in said lease aforesaid that a well should be drilled and completed on said premises within six months from the date thereof; And,

Whereas, it is the desire of the party of the first part to extend the time of drilling and completing said well for a period of 30 days;

It is therefore understood and agreed, that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) to party of the first part in hand paid by said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further consideration on the part of the party of the second part to commence drilling operations at once and to continue the same until a well is completed, then said party of the first part agrees that the time be extended in drilling and completing a well as provided for in said lease for a period of 30 days, subject however to all the other terms and conditions of said lease.
