FARM LEASE.

This indenture made this 18th day of October, 1910, between Richard Adkins, party of the first part, and Lula A. Jordan of Jenks, Okla. county, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that said party of the first part does hereby let and lease ^{to said second part.} for the term of five, beginning on the 1st day of January, 1910, and ending on 31st day of December, 1916, the following described property to-wit:

The southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of sec thirty-one, township eighteen north, and range thirteen east.

In consideration whereof, said party of the second part hereby covenants and agrees First to put 40 acres or as nearly as may be acres ~~acres~~ and to cultivate in a good, careful and workmanlike manner, and at proper times, all the tillable land on said premises to the satisfaction of said first party.

Sixth; to pay to said first party as rent the sum of fifty dollars, \$50.00 cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

The lessee agrees to fence said land with a three wire fence.

Possession of the other premises is to be surrendered 12-31-1916.
