## ORDER APPROVING SALE

In the county court of Creek county, state of Oklahoma.

In the matter of the estate of Noonley Wilson, deceased.

## ORDER.

And now on this 26 day of January, 1911, came on to be heard, the petition of Mahala Leader, the mother and the sole and only heir at law of Noonley Wilson, deceased.

Said petitioner appearing by her attorney James J. Mars, and after hearing the testimony and the argument of counsel; and the court being fully advised in the premises doth find;

That Noonley Wilson was a full-blood Creek Indian and duly enrolled as such; that by reason thereof, he had allotted to him the following described real estate, to-wit:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section nine (9) township seventeen (17) north, range thirteen (13) east, except that portion occupied by the Midland Valley R. R. Company, as right of way.

The court further finds that the said Noonley Wilson died intestate on the 6th day of July, 1910, leaving as his sole and only heirs at law, Mahala Leader, his mother, all of whom are of full and legal age;

The court further finds that the said Noonley Wilson, had no issue born to him since the fourth day of March, nineteen hundred and six;

The court further finds that the said Mahala Leader as the sole and only heirs at law of the said Noonley Wilson, deceased, on the 23rd day of September, 1910, made and executed to R.L. Cummings, her certain warranty deed, conveying to said R.L. Cummings, all of her right, title and interest, in and to the above described land; which said deed was delivered to this court pending the approval thereof.

The court further finds that the consideration of twenty five hundred (\$2500.00) dollars, for the above described land aforesaid, is adequate, and that ten hundred fifty (\$1050) dollars has been paid by said R.L. Cummings, into this court for the said legal representative of the said Mahala Leader, heir of Noonley Wilson, allottee, deceased, \$200.00 having been paid heretofore to Mahala Leader, and that the balance has been duly secured by vendor's lien on said land.

It is therefore, here now, by the court considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the deed as presented herewith be and the same is hereby approved according to section 9, of an act of congress approved May 27th 1906, entitled an act for the removal of restrictions from part of the lands of the allottees of the five civilized tribes; and for other purposes (Public No 140).
