

VACATION OF A PART OF THE PLAT OF FRISCO  
ADDITION TO TULSA, OKLAHOMA.

Know all men by these presents:

That whereas, heretofore, to-wit, on the 5th day of November, A D. 1910, at 11 o'clock A. M. Grant R. McCullough, trustee, did file with the register of deeds of Tulsa county, Oklahoma, a plat of a sub-division of the-

SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of sec 36, township 20 N. range 12 E; and all that part of lot 1 which lies north of the Frisco railroad in Sec 1, township 19 N range 12 east; all being in Tulsa county, Oklahoma; and,

Whereas, said sub-division was designated and named Frisco addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the streets and alleys in said addition and as shown by said plat, were dedicated to and for the use of the public, and all lots and blocks were reserved by said owner for use and sale; and,

Whereas, all of blocks nine (9) ten (10) and eleven (11) in said Frisco addition are now owned by and held of record in the name of Grant R. McCullough, trustee, said blocks and the lots therein numbered and contained being designated on said plat as Factory Sites; and,

Whereas, it is the desire of the said Grant R. McCullough, trustee, to vacate all of said plat above named lying south of Archer street therein, the same comprising all of Blocks 9, 10, and 11 and the streets and alleys therein contained;

Now, therefore, I, Grant R. McCullough, trustee, being the owner of all of that part of the Frisco addition to Tulsa Oklahoma, lying south of Archer street, the same consisting of blocks 9, 10, and 11 and the streets and alleys therein contained, do hereby declare the same as last above described to be vacated and held for naught, the same as if ~~no plat~~ of that part thereof had heretofore been filed; and I further request and direct that the register of deeds of Tulsa county, Oklahoma shall enter this declaration of vacation of record as is provided for under the laws of Oklahoma.
