It appearing to this Court from the verified petition of Kizzie Jefferson filed herein on the 5th day of January 1911 that she is a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation of Indians, enrolled upon the citizenship rolls of said nation, opposite roll number 2913; that she is a sister and one of the heirs at law of Gabriel Emarthia, deceased That the said Gabriel Emarthia was a full blood Creek Indian, as shown on the citizenship rolls of said nation, opposite roll number 6877; that as such citizen he had allotted to him by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes of Indians as his Separate allotment of land, the following described real estate situate in Tulsa county State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of section twelve township nineteen, north, range eleven east: That the said Gabriel Emarthia died intestate in Tulsa County, on the 7th day of July 1910 leaving surviving him as his sole heirs at law:

Samson Saper, his brother, Kizzie Jefferson, his sister that upon the death of the said Gabriel Emarthia, the heirs above named each became vested with an undivided one half interest in and to an undivided one half interest in the above described real estate.
