Oil and Gas Mining Lease, upon land selected for allotment, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory. (Sec 72, act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat., 716, 726)

This indenture of lease, made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this 1st day of March, A. D. 1905, by and between Lizzie Swimmer, a Cherokee citizen by blood, of Stilwell, Indian Territory, party of the first part and The Shawnee Oil & Gas Company, of Collinsville, Indian Territory, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Indian Territory and duly authorized to carry on business in the Indian Territory by compliance with the act of Congress, approved February 18, 1901, (31 Stat., 794) party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress, approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the secretary of the Interior thereunder.
