OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Lease, transferable only with consent of the secretary of the Interior.

Oil and Gas mining lease upon land selected for allotment Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory Sec 72, act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat., 716, 726)

This indenture of lease, made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this 18th day of September, A. D. 1906, by and between Runabout Lewis of Turley, Indian Territory, party of the first part, lessor, and The Shawnee Oil & Gas Company, of Collinsville, Indian Territory, party of the second part, lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72, of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the secretary of the Interior thereunder.

Witnesseth, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed, and performed by the party of the second part, its heirs, successors and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its heirs, successors and assigns, for the term of fifteen years from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following-described tract of land, lying and being within the Cherokee Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory to wit: South east quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) and the east half (1/2) of the southeast quarter (1/4)
