

ASSIGNMENT.

Whereas, the secretary of the interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated July 9th 1904, entered into by and between Frank Harlow, lessee, and Lizzie Chisholm, lessor, covering the following described land in the Cherokee Nation, in Tulsa county, Oklahoma, to wit:

The north half of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section thirteen (13) township twenty-one (21) north, range twelve (12) east, together with other lands not hereby assigned, and,

Whereas, on the 18th day of September, 1907, the said Frank Harlow, as assignor, executed an assignment of an undivided three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) interest in and to said lease to the Shawnee Oil & Gas Company, as assignee, which said assignment was on the 9th day of March, 1908, duly approved by the secretary of the interior.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Shawnee Oil & Gas Company, assignee of an undivided three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) interest in and to the above described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns and conveys all of its undivided three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) right, title and interest in and to said lease in so far as it covers the above described lands subject to the approval of the secretary of the interior, to S. W. Parish, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the Gypsy Oil Company.
