There is allow herey granted the right to erect and mainstain upon and across said premises, a line of poles and telegraph and telephnes wires thereon, and also to lay adjacent to and parallel with the first pipe line a second pipe line, and the grantee, its sudcessors and assigns, shall at all reasonable times have the right of ingress and egress to and from said line or lines for the purpose of construction, inspecting, repairing and maintaining the same and the removal of such at will in whole or in part.
