## Release

This indenture made and entered into this 17th day of Nov. 1910 by and between The Indianokla Oil & Gas Co., a corporation of the State of Ohio with its situs at Marietta in said State, as party of the first part, and Bettie Frank of Mounds, Creek County, Oklahoma party of the second part, witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar cash in hand paid by the second party to the first party, the first party does hereby remise, release and quit-claim unto the second party, her heirs, executors and administrators, all of the interest of the first party in all of the oil and natural gas beneath and under the following described lands lying in Creek County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the N  $\frac{1}{2}$  of N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Town 16 N, Range 13 E, containing 120 acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the said interest of the first party unto the party of the second part, her heirs, executors and administrators without recourse on the party of the first part, or its successors or assigns.

This quit-claim and release is of the interest of the first party under an oil and gas mining lease executed by the party of the second part, covering said lands, to the first party, on the 7th day of February 1906 said lease being recorded in Record Book 17, at page 541 thereof, in the office of the Register of Deeds for Creek County, at Sapulpa, in said County and State of Oklahoma; this release and quit-claim is for the sole purpose of releasing and discharging said lease and for no other purpose.
