TRUSTEES' DEED.

Whereas on the 7th day of November 1906, Clifton George and Mary D. George, his wife of Tulsa, Indian Territory, now state of Oklahoma, as grantors, executed acknowledged, and delivered to the Union Trust Company, Indian Territory, now State of Oklahoma, as trustee a Warranty Deed to certain lots in Dawson, (I.T.) Oklahoma, of which the lots hereinafter described are a part, which deed was recorded November 16th 1906, in Record 2, page 233 in the office of the Deputy U. S. Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder At Tulsa, Indian Territory.

Now Therefore, this indenture made this 21st day of December 1910 between the Union Trust Company as such trustee party of the first part and W. N. Clark party of the second part,

Witnesseth; that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty 00/100 dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part, as such trustee in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by said Trust Deed, has granted, bargained sold and conveyed, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following described real property, lying and situate in Dawson, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots eleven (11) and twelve (12) in block twenty-eight (28) as per recorded amended plat thereof. together with the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

To have to hold the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. and the party of the first part covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that it will, as such trustee, forever, warrant and defend the title to the said real property in and to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against all claims or acts of the first party and those of all persons claiming by, through or under it, and no other.

In witness whereof, the party of the first part hereto has caused these presents to be signed in its name by its President, attested by its Secretary, and its corporate seal to be affixed, by authority of its Board of Directors, and by-laws, this 21st day of December 1910
