And now on this 24th day of December, 1910, came on for hearing and consideration the report of George W. Johnson, as the guardian of Percy L. Johnson, Cherrie E. Johnson, Robert E. Johnson, Samuel M. Johnson, and Bessie Johnson, minors, in the matter of the execution of an oil and gas mining lease of the interest of said minors for a term of five years and as much longer thereafter as oil and gas is produced in paying quantities, and the terms of said lease being for one-eighth royalty of oil, \$200.00 for each utilized gas well and a well to be completed within six months from the date of such lease otherwise the same to be null and void, and lease being joined in by the adult heirs of the estate of said decedent, and the same being made in favor of Sam Rabinovitz, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a copy of such lease being attached to said report said guardian appearing in person and by his attorney.

And the court having duly examined the said report and the lease thereto attached does find; that the same has been executed in accordance with the order of the court, authorizing such execution made and entered herein on the 24th day of December, 1910, and that the same should be by the court approved as required by law.

The court therefore doth adjudge, order, and decree that said lease herein executed by George W. Johnson, as guardian of Percy L. Johnson, Luis G. Johnson, Cherrie E. Johnson, Robert E. Johnson, and Bessie Johnson, minors, upon the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 36, township 21 north, range 12 east, containing 10 acres more or less, situated in Tulsa county, state of Oklahoma, allotted lands of Cherokee C. Johnson, the deceased mother of said minors, to Sam Rabinovitz, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.
