F. Steil as lessee and by said Steil assigned unto G. C. Hughes and by said G. C. Hughes assigned unto Fife Oil and Gas Company, a corporation and by said Fife Oil and Gas company assigned unto said Earle T. Miller of Muskogee, Oklahoma, and a one half interest in said lease being assigned unto said Frank S. Foster of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said lease and the assignment thereof of above set forth covering a part of the allotment of Joe Leverett which said part of said allotment is more accurately described as the Southwest quarter of the South east quarter of Section Three (3) township nineteen (19) north range 11 east of Indian Meridian and situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
