If the lessee makes reasonable and bona fide effort to find and produce oil in paying quantity as is herein required of there and such effort is unsuccessful, they may at any time thereafter, with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, surrender and wholly terminate this lesse upon the full payment and performance of all there there existing obligations hereunder: Provided, however, That approval of such surrender by the Secretary
