

## ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT AND INCORPORATION

OF

*Cuscura Company*

**Know all Men by these Presents,** That the Corporators hereinafter named have this day, and by these presents, formed a Corporation under and in pursuance of an Act of Congress approved February 18th, 1901, entitled "An Act to put in force in the Indian Territory certain provisions of the Laws of Arkansas relating to Corporations and to make said provisions applicable to said Territory," which said Act provides for incorporations for manufacturing and other lawful business purposes in the Indian Territory, and in evidence thereof do hereby execute the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of said Corporation shall be *Cuscura Company*

SECOND: The Corporators are

*Robert H. Johnson William L. Horrell John Hancock and James R. Burrsides*

THIRD: The place of business is to be located at *Tulsa Indian Territory in the United States in foreign countries* and its office for the transaction of business shall be in *Tulsa Indian Territory* or at such other place as the Board of Directors may select.

FOURTH: The general nature of the business proposed to be transacted by this Corporation is *the manufacturing & selling either retail or wholesale of a certain hair tonic & toilet preparation known as Cuscura hair tonic* the manufacturing & selling either retail or wholesale of any other hair tonics & toilet preparations together with the right to take out and own all necessary trademarks & with the further right to buy hold with full power of alienation all real estate & buildings necessary in the successful conducting of its business & with the further right to do all things necessary & usual & proper in the successful conducting of a similar business

FIFTH: The amount of capital stock of said Corporation shall be *Five thousand* Dollars; of which *four thousand four hundred* Dollars has been subscribed by the Corporators aforesaid, and the residue thereof may be issued and disposed of as the Board of Directors may from time to time order and direct.

SIXTH: The capital stock shall be divided into *two hundred* shares of the value of \$25.00 each.

SEVENTH: The affairs and business of the Corporation shall be conducted and controlled by a Board of Directors, consisting of *four* members, all of whom shall be stockholders of the Corporation. Said Board of Directors shall elect one of its members as President, and one of its members as Vice-President, and shall also elect a Secretary and Treasurer.

EIGHTH: The first election of Directors shall be held immediately after the organization of the Corporation and said Directors shall serve for one year and until their successors are elected.

NINTH: The Board of Directors are empowered to ordain and establish all by-laws and regulations necessary to the management and business of said Corporation, and alter and repeal same at pleasure.

TENTH: The first meeting of said Corporators for organization shall be held in *Tulsa Indian Territory* at the office of *Galley & Harbage* at *3* o'clock *P.M.* on the *24th* day of *December* 190*6*. The subscribers hereto hereby waive notice of said meeting.
