D Anodryputicate AND GAS MINING LEASE OIL UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT, CHEROKEE NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY (Sec. 72, Act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat., 716, 726.) This Indenture of Lease, Made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this Third day of april A. D. 190 b, by and between \_ Oflive Martin of Blanemore, Such Ly port 4 of the first part and Franks a. Gillespile, of hidepursone, Kaucas part y of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder. WITNESSETH: That the part \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, cavenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed, and performed by the part \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ here, accelerations or administrators do \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ hereby demise, grant, and let unto the part \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ here, executors or administrators (do \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_) years from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the Cherokee Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The... East half of the South East quarter, township Eurouty time (21) Partile range the Thirty (20) (13) tach of section. of the Indian Meridian, and containing Cyfling (50) acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine, and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface of said land as may be reasonably extract, pipe, store, refine, and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the stirate of said land us may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining, and removing such oil and natural gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and including still further the right to use such oil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necessary to the prosecution of said operations. In consideration of which the part of the second part hereby, agrees and binds. do not, before the tenth day of the month succeeding its extraction, agree upon the value of the crude oil on the leased premises, the value thereof shall finally be determined under the direction of the Secretary of the Interior in such manner as he shall prescribe, and to so pay the royalty accruing for any month on or before the twenty-fifth day of the month succeeding, and where the value of the crude oil fluctuates, the average value during the month shall month on or before the twenty-fifth day of the month succeeding, and where the value of the crude of fluctuates, the average value during the month shall constitute the criterion in computing the royalty; and to pay in yearly payments, at the end, of each year, one hundred and fifty dollars royalty, on each gas-producing well, the lessor\_\_\_\_\_\_to have free the use of gas for lighting and warming \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ residence on the premises. But failure on the part of the lessee\_\_\_\_\_\_to use a gas-producing well where the same cannot be reasonably utilized at the rate so prescribed, shall not work a forfeiture of this lease so far as the same relates to mining oil, but if the lessee\_\_\_\_\_\_desires to retain gas-producing privileges\_\_\_\_\_\_\_shall pay a royalty of fifty dollars per annum on each gas-producing well not utilized, the first payment to become due and to be made within thirty days from the date of the discovery of gas, payments thereafter for such wells to be made in advance at the first of each succeeding year, dating from the first payment. And the part \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part further agrees and binds <u>\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_</u>, <u>here</u>, <u>her</u> second years; Thirty cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the third and fourth years; and Seventy-five cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the fifth and each succeeding year thereafter of the term for which this lease is to run; it being understood and agreed that said sums of money so paid shall be a credit on the stipulated royalties should the same exceed such sums paid as advanced royalty, and further, that should the part S. of the second part neglect or refuse to pay such advanced annual royalty for the period of sixty days after the same becomes due and payable, then this lease shall, at the by this lease, and to drill at least one well thereon within twelve months from the date of the approval of the bond by the Secretary of the Interior, and should the part <u>finite</u> of the second part fail, neglect, or refuse to drill at least one well within the time stated, this lease may, in the discretion of the Secretary, be declared null and void, with due notice to the lessee <u>and proof of the default</u>; and said part <u>finite</u> of the second part agrees to operate the same in a workmanlike manner to the fullest possible extent, unavoidable cusualties excepted; to commit no waste upon the said land, and to suffer no waste to be committed upon the portion in <u>finite</u> occupancy or use; to take good care of the same, and to promptly surrender and return the premises upon the termination of this lease to the part <u>finite</u> of the first part or to whomsoever shall be lawfully entitled thereto, and not to remove thereform any buildings or improvements erected thereon during the said term by the said part <u>finite</u> of the second part, but said buildings and improvements shall remain a part of said land and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the consideration for this lease, in addition to the other considerations herein genetified excending that tools, boilers, builter, buyes, nine lines, numbing and drilling outfits tanks, engines, and the considerations herein specified, excepting that tools, boilers, boiler-houses, pipe lines, pumping and drilling outfits, tanks, engines, and machinery, and the casing of all dry or exhausted wells, shall remain the property of the said part g. of the second part, and may be removed at any time before the expiration of sixty days from the termination of the lease; that g. will not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under g. control, nor days from the termination of the lease; that the will not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under the control, nor allow any intoxicating liquors to be sold or given away for any purposes on such premises; that the will not use such premises for any other than that authorized in this lease, and that before abandoning any well Me it will securely plug the same so as to effectually shut off all water above the oil-bearing horizon. And it is mutually understood and agreed that no sublease, assignment or transfer of this lease or of any interest therein or thereunder can be directly or indiractly made without the written consent thereto of the lessor and the Secretary of the Interior first obtained, and that any such assignment or e or attempted without such consent shall be void. he And the said part & of the second part further covenants and agrees that \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ will keep an accurate account of all oil mining operations, showing the whole amount of oil mined or removed, and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implements, tools, movable machinery, and other personal chattels used in said prospecting and mining operations, and upon all of the oil obtained from the land herein leased, as security for the payment of said royalties. And the part 4 of the second part agrees that this indenture of lease shall in all respects be subject to the rules and regulations heretofore or that And the part \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part agrees that this indenture of lease shall in all respects be subject to the rules and regulations heretofore or that may hereafter be lawfully prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to oil and gas leases in the Cherokee Nation. And the said part \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part expressly agrees that should \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_\_ sublessees, heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns, violate any of the covenants, slipulations, or provisions of this lease, or fail for the period of sixty days to pay the stipulated monthly royalty provided for herein, then the part \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the first part shall be at liberty, in \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ discretion, to avoid this indenture of lease and cause the same to be annulled, when all the right, franchises, and privileges of the part \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ sublessees, heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns hereunder shall cease and ond without further proceedings.
