

It is further agreed and understood that this lease shall be of no force or effect unless the part 4 of the second part shall, within sixty days from the date of approval of the application filed in connection herewith, furnish a satisfactory bond in accordance with the regulations of ²⁴⁶⁴ March 20, 1906, prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, which shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of this lease.
