

RENTAL CONTRACT.

COMPARED

This Contract, Made and entered into this 1st day of June A. D. 1910 by and between
James Warley of
 Ind. Ter., for Stone Bluff area for and on behalf of _____
 years old _____ citizen of the Creek Nation,

part of the first part, and Roy R. Getman, part of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part of the second part, the part of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, for agricultural purposes for the term of five years from the 1st day of June A. D. 1910 the following described parcels of land:

E 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Section 26 Township 15 N., Range 13 E
NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 26 Township 18 N., Range 13 E
 _____ of Section _____ Township _____ N., Range _____ E
 _____ of Section _____ Township _____ N., Range _____ E

It is understood and agreed that the part of the second part shall pay to the part of the first part a rental of \$ 55.00 per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows:

\$ 27.50 January 1, and July 1, 1911 \$ 27.50 January 1, and July 1, 1912
 \$ 27.50 January 1, and July 1, 1913 \$ 27.50 January 1, and July 1, 1914
27.50 Jan 1 and July 1, 1915

It is further understood and agreed that the part of the second part, shall build, construct, and erect on said premises the following improvements, which shall become the property of the part of the first part at the termination of this contract, to-wit:

Put out an orchard of 200 fruit trees within three years from date of this contract.

the receipt of \$ 10.00 is hereby acknowledged part payment 1911 rental.

It is further agreed that all such improvements made for farming and grazing purposes aforesaid shall remain and be the property of the part of the second part, and should the part of the second part be deprived of the use of said land or any part thereof before the expiration of this contract, then and in either event he shall have the privilege of removing said structures and improvements or disposing of them as he may see fit, but if he shall be permitted to have the use of the premises for the full period provided herein and this contract shall have been fully completed in conformity with the terms herein expressed then said structures and other improvements shall be turned over and delivered to the part of the first part in good condition and repair, less ordinary wear and tear.

It is further agreed that this contract and its stipulations, shall be binding upon our respective heirs and legal representatives.
