## ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT AND INCORPORATION

Of

*The Tulsa Hospital Association  
of Tulsa Indian Territory*

**Know all Men by these Presents,** That the Corporators hereinafter named have this day, and by these presents, formed a Corporation under and in pursuance of an Act of Congress approved February 18th, 1901, entitled "An Act to put in force in the Indian Territory certain provisions of the Laws of Arkansas relating to Corporations and to make said provisions applicable to said Territory," which said Act provides for incorporations for manufacturing and other lawful business purposes in the Indian Territory, and in evidence thereof do hereby execute the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of said Corporation shall be *The Tulsa Hospital Association*

SECOND: The Corporators are *Dr. Fred S. Clinton, Dr. C. J. Wiley, Dr. James S. McAllister  
and Dr. C. F. Reeder*

THIRD: The place of business is to be located at *Tulsa Indian Territory* and its office for the transaction of business shall be in *Tulsa Indian Territory* or at such other place as the Board of Directors may select.

FOURTH: The general nature of the business proposed to be transacted by this Corporation is *to acquire, own, dispose of, lease, erect, both real and personal, to erect, construct, equip, operate, maintain, buildings, grounds, for hospital purposes, to construct, operate, maintain, necessary water, heat & light plants, also private sanitary, sewerage, system, to borrow money, to borrow money, to execute notes & bonds, mortgages or other securities, to secure same by hypothecate, notes, bonds, certificates of stock or other securities as may be deemed necessary by its Board of Directors to receive gifts by bequest or otherwise, to act as trustee or administrator, to contract for the employment of nurses, to conduct a graded, term training school for nurses, and issue diplomas of proficiency as provided for in its by-laws*

FIFTH: The amount of capital stock of said Corporation shall be *Forty Thousand (\$40,000)* Dollars; of which *One thousand (\$1,000.00)* Dollars has been subscribed by the Corporators aforesaid, and the residue thereof may be issued and disposed of as the Board of Directors may from time to time order and direct.

SIXTH: The capital stock shall be divided into *Forty* shares of the value of \$25.00 each.

SEVENTH: The affairs and business of the Corporation shall be conducted and controlled by a Board of Directors, consisting of *four* members, all of whom shall be stockholders of the Corporation. Said Board of Directors shall elect one of its members as President, and one of its members as Vice-President, and shall also elect a Secretary and Treasurer.

EIGHTH: The first election of Directors shall be held immediately after the organization of the Corporation and said Directors shall serve for one year and until their successors are elected.

NINTH: The Board of Directors are empowered to ordain and establish all by-laws and regulations necessary to the management and business of said Corporation, and alter and repeal same at pleasure.

TENTH: The first meeting of said Corporators for organization shall be held in *Tulsa Indian Territory* at the office of *Dr. Fred S. Clinton* at *three* o'clock *P.M.* on the *22nd* day of *November* 190*6*. The subscribers hereto hereby waive notice of said meeting.
